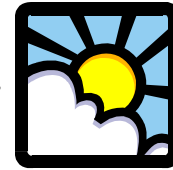

Kentucky's First Lady Jane Beshear will be guest speaker at the Frankfort Chamber of Commerce June “In the Know” Breakfast on Tuesday, June 16, 2009 in the Frankfort Regional Medical Center Pavilion Conference Room.

Ms. Beshear spearheaded the Kentucky Mansion Celebration, a wonderful revitalization and makeover project that will revive one of Frankfort's most historic buildings—the Old Governor's Mansion—using no state funds and at no cost to taxpayers.

The Kentucky Mansion Celebration committee encompasses several former first ladies, the Kentucky Executive Mansion Foundation (KEMFI), Division of Historic Properties and the Historic Properties Advisory Commission (HPAC). The design boards submitted by the interior designers were approved by KEMFI and HPAC in May and work began in early June. The first floor of the mansion will be re-opened for tours and interpreted by guides. The second and third floors will be available to dignitaries and economic development guests of the Governor. The Mansion will be open to the public for tours beginning September 19th.

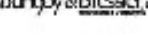
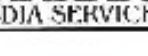
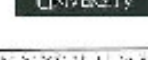
